




Scudo Freestanding

- Custom sizes and finishes available


Freestanding

- Five distinctive shapes
- Overall height with base: 137 or 165 cm, depending on shape
- Overall width: 75, 92 or 107 cm, depending on shape
- Floor-protection seal in polyester

Worksurface

- Overall height with feet: 65 cm
- 4 frontal screen lengths, to accommodate most worksurfaces
- Feet with anti-slip pads
